### ENERGY FROM WASTE INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN

The NSW Government has today released an Energy from Waste Infrastructure Plan to support the NSW Waste and Sustainable Materials Strategy 2041.

The plan guides strategic planning for future thermal energy from waste facilities and identifies priority areas where energy from waste infrastructure is to be located.

These priority areas include West Lithgow, Parkes, Richmond Valley and Southern Goulburn Mulwaree.

As a consequence of this new policy direction, Jerrara Power Pty Ltd will be withdrawing its State significant development application for an energy from waste facility at 974 Jerrara Road, Bungonia.

Jerrara Power remains committed to the development of an energy from waste facility in NSW.

Jerrara Power thanks all stakeholders and the local community for their time and input into the planning and consultation activities undertaken to date.
